2019 Club Rules & Regulations

REGISTRATION

- All members and guests are required to register in the Pro Shop before starting play.
- Players **must call** for tee times at all times and report to the shop ready to play 10 minutes prior to their tee time.
- Members, who make tee times for a weekend morning, must call the Pro Shop to cancel. Members who fail to call the Pro Shop to cancel will lose weekend morning privileges for the following weekend morning.
- All players must have a bag with clubs.
- Resident members must call the Pro Shop when intending to play a few holes from their homes. This ensures that golfers already on the course are not interrupted and minimizes the risk of being hit by golf balls. Any member not reporting in at the Pro Shop or calling, before going out will be told to leave the course. On weekends all players must start on the 1st tee until 6:00pm.

The golf course is open from March 31 to December 1.

Golf Shop Hours will be posted in the Pro Shop.

GUESTS

- Members must sign in guests in the Pro Shop before the round and may only play from the 1st tee.
- Members with a guest must use a cart.
- Members with two or more guests may tee off on weekends and holidays only after noon.
- Guests are subject to the same rules as their host. It is the responsibility of the member to ensure that their guests comply.
- **A person may be a guest at the Club a maximum of eight times per year. A guest may play a maximum of two times in a calendar month.**

FEES

- Fees for daily play can be paid by cash or credit card.
- Fees for Tournament play can be paid only by cash or check or credit card
- Special functions separate from golf can be paid by cash or check.
- All merchandise purchases can be paid by check, cash, credit card or gift certificate.

GOLF CART RULES

- Players must sign in and pay for carts before starting play.
- Golf cart operators must have a valid driver's license. □ No more than two people are allowed in a cart.
- Golf carts are mandatory before 3:00pm on weekends and holidays from June through August and before 2 p.m. on weekends and holidays throughout the remainder of the season
- Carts must stay on paths near tees and greens. Drivers must obey posted signs.
- Carts may never be parked or left unattended on the street! Park carts in the designated areas.

GOLF ETIQUETTE

PACE OF PLAY

- Play as quickly as possible and avoid unnecessary delays. Leave the green promptly. 9 holes should be played in 2 hours or less. (*Pace of play means keeping up with the group in front of you, not behind you*).
- A group that loses more than one clear hole must permit players they are holding up to play through.
- It is the duty of players entitled to go through, to insist upon their right in order to ensure speedy play. Any group that slows down play and refuses to let the faster group through will lose early tee time privileges for the following week.
- Players hitting their ball in another fairway will wait until the group playing that hole has passed.
- **Fivesomes are not permitted**, unless the Golf Professional or his representative gives prior approval.
- Be considerate of your fellow golfers by replacing all divots, raking bunkers and repairing ball marks on the greens.
- Repeat offenders of these rules will have their playing privileges suspended.

GOLF ATTIRE

- **SOFT SPIKES ARE MANDATORY.**
- Proper golf attire is required at all times.
- Shirts must have collars and tucked in. Shorts must be of Bermuda length.
- Tank tops, T-shirts, tights, NO jeans of any type, warm up suits; halter-tops, work or street shoes are not permitted.
- Failure to comply with the dress code will result in play being denied.
- Brims of caps are to face forward

COURSE CONDUCT

- Throwing golf clubs will not be tolerated and will result in a fine or suspension.
- Excessive foul language is forbidden.
- Excessive drinking and abusive language will not be tolerated on the golf club property.
- Skipping holes during a round is dangerous to golfer safety and is not allowed.
- Retrieving golf balls on townhouse property is prohibited.
- Any complaints about the course or members should be in writing and turned in to the Pro Shop where it will be forwarded to the Golf Committee.

PRACTICING ON THE COURSE

- The practice tee is open weekdays provided you call the Pro Shop and request permission prior to practicing.
- The practice tee is open on weekends after 6:00pm.
- There will be no practicing to greens or from the fairways or rough anywhere on the course.
- Colored practice balls or well-marked balls are required.

HANDICAPPING

- All members must establish a USGA handicap.
- Members without a USGA handicap index will not be allowed to play in any club tournaments or special events.
- At the completion of 18 holes, a member must properly adjust scores and enter into the computer
- Any player not turning in a scorecard will be given a score of par for the round.

FURTHER INFORMATION

- Lockers and Bag Room storage will be assigned upon request at the Pro Shop.
- Coolers are not allowed on the course. All drinks must be purchased at the golf course restaurant.

SPECIAL NOTE

- TUESDAYS AND WEDNESDAYS ARE LEAGUE NIGHTS. THE COURSE CLOSES TO MEMBERS AT 4:45 P. M. FROM MID APRIL TO THE END OF SEPTEMBER. ALL CARTS MUST BE IN BY 4:30.
- TUESDAY MORNINGS ARE SET ASIDE FOR WOMEN'S GOLF, STARTING AT 9 A.M. AND TEE TIMES ARE SCHEDULED AFTER THEIR TEE TIMES

MONDAY IS THE DAY THAT OUTINGS ARE HELD AND THE CLUB OPENS AT 12PM EVERY MONDAY DURING THE SEASON. (*Notices will be posted; however, members may wish to call in and check for any last minute changes*).
